- 1. Secretary/ Treasurer's report: General Account: \$85,439.84 Gaming Account: \$14,632.05 Raffle Holding \$12,400 Sponsorship Account \$8755.06 Accounts Receivable and Payable sheets were presented.**
- 2. Committee Report: Strathmore- was strong, best they have had, changes will be made for next year. Dunmore- great rodeo and strong, Stettler is being done by the committee rodeo now. Thorsby Rodeo came back ok with a 24% hold back. New fee structure is helping with expenses.**
- 3. Event Directors Report- Barrel Racing nothing, Marina would like her name on the agenda instead of Paige.**

**Tie Down – Strathmore, Standoff and Dunmore stock has been great, calves nothing but good things from the contractors, complaints about cattle at Thorsby and Rimbey rodeos of not cattle being in the correct age category, was fixed for the second day.**

**Breakaway Roping- Lorne nothing, Millie- a contestant was asked to take the spare calf than what was drawn for, instead of finding the correct stock draw, ended up taking stock that was drawn for. Judge asked to take the spare, judges were checking everyone's string tied to the horn as they entered the box, in the rule book. Will be checked every rodeo from now on. Cheat sheet for judges.**

**Ribbon Roping- Mark nothing from Ribbon Roping, has two items will wait for new business.**

**Team Roping – Doug – issue with rule in the book being vague about entering twice in one event, rule was shortened from previous rule books, had nothing to fall back on, contestants know they can not enter twice in the same event, rule was shortened from the 2010 rule book, discuss later that if a drawn partner can be brought it.**

**TEAM ROPING: PG 25 Section C rule amendment – If a team roping/ ribbon roping partner draws out after positions are drawn, the remaining partner may also draw out having only his entry and event fees returned, or he may get another partner from any of the contestants already entered in the rodeo not in the same event regardless of age category, no contestant can compete twice in the team roping or ribbon roping. In Favor: 11 Opposed: 1**

**Rule Changes: pg 8 the board of directors have the power to change and alter any rules at any time within the rodeo year as needed, rule changes can be made by the board other than at the annual meeting.**

**Back numbers priced out at \$8.50 per number from the same company as last year. Need 110-115 approx.**

**Niki – the board of directors to buy 1 or 2 sets of books from the Cash Raffle – if the board wins the money will be donated back to the association.**
